## **Overview:**

This assignment is part of the week 15 module on The Environment and Mental Health. Over the course of this semester, we have used the socio-ecological model (SEM) to explore the interactions with the individual and their communities and environment. In the final level of the SEM, we explore the effects of the physical environment on mental health including negative stressors like noise, weather, pollution, natural disasters, and war, and positive factors like trees, plants, fresh air, and clean water.

Disaster Mental/Behavioral Health is the provision of mental health, substance abuse, and stress management services to disaster survivors and responders. It addresses the psychological, emotional, cognitive, developmental, and social impacts that disasters, emergencies, or incidents have on survivors and first responders as they respond and recover.

This <u>CONVERGE Disaster Mental Health (DMH) Training Module</u> focuses on mental health outcomes associated with disasters, with a particular emphasis on risk factors over time that make certain populations vulnerable to poor disaster mental health outcomes. Although it has been developed for disaster researchers and practitioners, the content is relevant to both public health and mental health.
