ETHICS IN RESEARCH CONVERGE TRAINING MODULES ASSIGNMENT

Overview:

Students are required to complete two CONVERGE training modules throughout the semester focused on ethics in research. Ethical action in disaster research is a major focus of the course and is an overarching concept explored throughout the semester. The first module required is **Broader Ethical Considerations for Hazards and Disaster Researchers** CONVERGE Training Module while the second is selected by each individual student from the other trainings available through CONVERGE.

Instructions:

Students must complete each of the respective CONVERGE modules, pass the necessary quizzes, and submit the appropriate certifications to a drop box by the listed due dates. The lessons learned and major takeaways from each module completed will be discussed in class.

Evaluation Criteria:

Students are graded primarily on completion and submission of the module certificate by the date required. Additional grading is assigned to overall discussion of the **Broader Ethical Considerations for Hazards and Disaster Researchers Training Module** and a brief presentation of lessons learned from the student-selected module.

Points Possible: 100 points each and 15% of the overall grade in the class (7.5% for each module)
